Student Referral Link

When students click your referral link they will see your institution at the top of the school matches, regardless of the match percentage. To direct students to your transfer matches, we suggest using this link when hyperlinking text or running ads.

Student Referral Badge

The referral badge is another alternative, it combines an image with the referral link.
